

## Is there Formaldehyde in vaccine? Why?

Formaldehyde is used early in the manufacturing process of some vaccines as a way of making viruses in the vaccine, harmless.

The formaldehyde is then removed during the rest of the manufacturing process, leaving at maximum only very tiny trace amounts in the vaccine.

By comparison, an infant's body naturally contains about ten times more formaldehyde at any time than there is in a vaccine.
